LOCAL LAW No. 2 of the Year 2007 of the TOWN OF DENNING, NEW YORK

**A LOCAL LAW EXTENDING THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR THE
HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT AND TOWN CLERK**

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Denning as follows,

Section 1. STATUTORY AUTHORITY: This Local Law is adopted pursuant to the provisions of Section 10(1)(ii)(d)(3) of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. INCREASE TERM OF OFFICE: The term of office of the elected Town Superintendent of Highways and Town Clerk shall be four (4) years. Such four (4) year term shall commence as of the first day of January following the first biennial Town election at which a person is elected to such office. Thereafter, the Town Superintendent of Highways and Town Clerk shall be elected for terms of four (4) years.

Section 3. MANDATORY REFERENDUM: This local law is adopted subject to a mandatory referendum and shall be submitted for approval of the qualified voters of the Town of Denning at the general election to be held on November 6th, 2007. A proposition in the following form shall be included on the ballot at such general Town election, and the increased term of office shall not take effect unless such proposition is approved by a majority vote of the qualified voters voting thereon:

“Shall Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2007, entitled “A Local Law Increasing the Term of Office of the Town Superintendent of Highways and Town Clerk from Two (2) Years to Four (4) Years be approved?”

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Local Law shall become effective immediately upon being filed in the office of the Secretary of State after approval by the qualified voters.
