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## Town of Denning - Planning Board Meeting

December 18, 2008 (rescheduled from December 11 due to bad weather)

### Planning Board Regular Meeting

The meeting of the Town of Denning Planning Board was called to order by Chairman Alden Thayer at 7:42 PM. Members present were Mr. Thayer, Mr. Brooks, Mr. Van Aken, Mr. Larison, Mr. Bobik and Mr. Landon. Mr. Krickhan wasn't able to attend.

Mr. Thayer read the minutes from the meeting of November 11th. Mr. Brooks motioned to accept the minutes, Mr. Bobik seconded, all in favor.

### New Business (first):

Mr. Thayer presented a notification for Logging Notification from Frost Valley. 540 trees and 14,000 board feet under the forest management plan already approved. SBL 42-2-40 and 42-2-39 20 Acres off Denning Rd. starting December 9th 2008. Reviewed the Logging Notification Form to see if it was adequate and complete. Everything looked okay and we signed off on the permit. We also discussed if it should be put on the "white board". We decided that we would but it isn't relevant as the new Logging Law hasn't passed the Town Board (still in limbo).

### Old Business:

Revisited the Outdoor Wood Boiler, Wind Generator, ideas with some discussion and no resolve once again. It was brought to our attention at the Zoning Committee meeting that we should look at the Hurleyville Outdoor Wood Boilers Law for an example of creating an ordinance. We discussed other towns attempts at restricting outdoor wood boilers.

### Other Business:

David Brooks gave us a summary of the Zoning Committee. We reviewed and discussed the new requirements set forth by Ulster County listing things that needed to be referred to Ulster County Planning Board. We currently do not have a representative to the Ulster County Board and Mr. Van Aken said he would consider filling the post. He will let us know next month. Mr. Larison discussed his experience as representative in the past few years.

We had a discussion about the things going on around town and weather we needed to be in the loop.

Discussed meeting at other times like Day light savings time meet at 7:30p and Standard time meet at 7:00p.

Next meeting is scheduled for January 8, 2008.
