**WHEREAS** the City of New York Department of Environmental Protection has conventionally decided to open properties owned by them to the public as - Public Access Areas (PAA), and

**WHEREAS** the Town of Denning does not wish to open Parcel ID 1183 and 2069, as a Public Access Area, but agree that the parcels should allow hiking, managed with Parcels ID's 1180 and 1181,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Board of the Town of Denning

**HEREBY** request the City of New York Department of Environmental Protection designate Parcel ID's 1183 and 2069 not open as Public Access Area's but managed along with Parcel ID's 1180 and 1181 be opened to the public for hiking only.
