**WHEREAS** the Town of Denning Town Board wishes to re-affirm Said resolution, and to include the East and West Branches of the Neversink River and

**WHEREAS** it is the duty, obligation and intention of the Denning Town Board to safeguard the Town of Denning's infrastructure and to limit the repeated destruction, repair and repetitive cost incurred by a consistent pattern of flooding, and

**WHEREAS** the continuous flooding of the Rondout Creek and the East and West Branches of the Neversink River which flows into the New York City Reservoir system, and the lack of cleaning of said stream of rocks and debris, has

**THEREFORE** caused the passage of water to flow in a destructive and cost prohibitive manner, repeatedly,

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS** the intention of the Denning Town Board to urge a thorough cleaning of all of the afore named streams by New York City and or a partnership with the involved Town.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the Denning Town Board **HEREBY** directs the Clerk to the Board to spread Said resolution upon the minutes of this meeting and to notify our neighboring towns of this resolution as well as our New York State elected officials.
