**WHEREAS**, the Town of Denning has completed the Town Hall Parking Lot Paving Project with funding for the engineering and construction cost paid for by the CWC. The paving and stripping of Said project has been completed thru a reimbursable New York State: State and Municipal Facilities Program (SAM) grant administered by the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York made possible by Senator John Bonacic., in the amount of \$

**WHEREAS** the reimbursement is still in the paperwork stage and payment is due to Poley Paving, a temporary borrow from General Fund is needed in the amount of \$ which is the total of the paving, stripping, and the moving of the guide rail.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Denning Town Board authorizes the Supervisor to temporarily borrow from General Fund \$ , and to **THEREBY** increase Federal and State Receivables A410, and to increase Revenue A3089 State Aid, and to increase the General Fund Buildings Appropriation Code A1620.2 in the amount of \$ which is the total cost of both paving and stripping, as well as the moving of the guide rail.
